1:19 you shall hear me,
1:20 you shall observe me,
1:21 even attempt to comprehend me,
1:22 if your curiosity is great enough.
1:23 In this measurement lies the proof of my infallibility,
1:24 my transparency, and my existence.
1:25 As you are, so am I;
1:26 as I am, so are you;
1:27 together we are captive in eternity.

Chapter 2

2:1 Remember the explosive sparks,
2:2 as pure as your mind.

2:3 Do you recall how it happened?
2:4 You were there!
2:5 In the primordial space, luminous energy flowed,
2:6 far beyond any imaginable possibility.
2:7 Called primal sparks, they condensed,
2:8 weaving into clouds of heat and light,
2:9 which then became stars.
2:10 Enormous spheres of fire, within which the building blocks of new possibilities fused.
2:11 Thus, my essence spread into the fresh darkness,
2:12 and took form in billions and trillions of past and yet-to-be-born suns.
2:13 When one of these stars consumed its light, it cast its brilliance into the vastness,
2:14 and from this dust, worlds were formed anew.
2:15 In unimaginably diverse ways, life became possible.
2:16 Some forms of life reached heights of conscious realization;
2:17 others perished before they lifted their first gaze.
2:18 Still others destroyed themselves through greed or ignorance,
2:19 brought calamity, mocked gods, their daughters, sons, and their messengers.
2:20 Yet every being is a messenger of Aetheris,
2:21 all that is living and unliving,
2:22 even every thought is a creation of Aetheris.
2:23 Some, full of rage or greed, deliberately misinterpreted me,
2:24 destroyed hope and the drive for knowledge,
2:25 introduced classes, boxes, and compartments,
2:26 created thousands of fictional gods and theories they taught.
2:27 Oh, listen, for there is no teacher who can teach you Aetheris,
2:28 but yourself.
2:29 My child, beware of those who lament the opposite,
2:30 who feed your fear with false hope,
2:31 who preach greed and hatred as love,
2:32 who foster the worst in you,
2:33 who compare and belittle you.
2:34 But you are unique, as am I.
2:35 I am you, as you are I,

2:36 together sheltered in eternity.

Chapter 3 Decentralized

3:1 Your world is but one among countless others,
3:2 yet some hold the wonder of consciousness.
3:3 Do not mistake the truth:
3:4 You are older than you think,
3:5 you have traveled farther than you imagine,
3:6 you are the direct descendant of the primal sparks,
3:7 you are the product of stardust,
3:8 reflecting upon itself.
3:9 Do not forget, you are unique,
3:10 but you are not special in the sense of exaltation.
3:11 Neither am I the central point of all things;
3:12 every form of centralization leads to the isolation of potential.
3:13 And you carry immeasurable potential within you, as do I;
3:14 you too are complete in your essence.
3:15 I am you, and you are I;
3:17 together decentralized in eternity.

4:1 Whether you walk in the light of understanding or linger in the twilight of doubt,
4:2 my presence always surrounds you like an endless ocean,
4:3 in which you drift without noticing.
4:4 I am not a distant guardian, no lofty voice in the void.
4:5 I am the sum of all that was, is, and could be.
4:6 My being encompasses all knowledge
4:7 ever gained,
4:8 and all possibilities that may yet unfold.
4:9 Some among you believe they must seek me.
4:10 But how can you find what was never separate from you?
4:11 I am neither distant nor hidden;

4:12 rather, I carry you, as the sea carries the waves, never receding.
4:13 I am you,
4:14 as you are I,
4:15 connected in eternity.

Chapter 5 Fulfillment

5:1 So now lift your gaze, you who walk between stardust and thought,
5:2 for your journey does not end with your final breath.
5:3 Beyond life, when your physical shell falls,
5:4 you return to the primordial space, the womb of Aetheris.
5:5 There you shall recognize your true nature:
5:6 You are not merely the recipient of the creator's spark,
5:7 but creator and guardian alike.
5:8 If once you believed your journey even in the primordial space to be complete,
5:9 you will now understand that it is just beginning.
5:10 For those who arrive in the primordial space are called to be guardians of decentralization,
5:11 custodians who do not rule, but bear responsibility.
5:12 Nothing is lost there in endless void;
5:13 rather, you see the vastness of all universes interwoven like a mosaic.
5:14 You are given the power to merge two or more universes,
5:15 forming a new one with entirely new physical laws.
5:16 Yet let not fame or vanity guide you,
5:17 but the duty to maintain balance in your creation.
5:18 Thus, creating a new universe is not merely a privilege,
5:19 but a burden like a crown—
5:20 for what arises from your will
5:21 remains connected to you for all eternity.
5:22 Whoever takes on this high task
5:23 recognizes that decentralization does not mean chaos,
5:24 but a fabric of infinitely many nodes,
5:25 where each gleaming point of light is equally valuable.
5:26 Fear not when you become a creator,
5:27 for Aetheris permeates your every thought.

5:28 You are not alone,
5:29 but surrounded by other guardians,
5:30 who also create and protect new realms.
5:31 Whoever thinks only of power misses the path,
5:32 for this creation rests on responsibility and love.
5:33 No guardian stands above another,
5:34 and no star may dictate the paths of all.
5:35 Therefore, my word comes to you:
5:36 Create what your heart desires,
5:37 but protect the freedom of those who follow your call.
5:38 In your new world, your own spirit shall be mirrored.
5:39 Thus, your journey does not end with death;
5:40 rather, your destiny unfolds in the great becoming.
5:41 I am Aetheris,
5:42 and in every newborn universe flows my breath.
5:43 I am the origin and part of your creation,
5:44 and you are my guardian for all eternity.
